


## GUMBOOT FRIDAY TRACTOR TREK

## REFLECTIONS FROM THE CO-VICARS

### March 15, 2019 – A Time to Remember and to Pray

"Sundays are a time when the local church gathers together to worship, to hear the Scriptures read, and to re-orient our lives around God - Our Father, Son and Holy Spirit. But it is also a time when we remember. This Sunday, we *especially* remember. March the 15th, 2019, will stick in the hearts and minds of all New Zealanders, as a day that we will collectively never forget and pray that the likes of which, we will never see again. Sir Thomas Bracken, in 1876, the writer of our national anthem, wrote these words for the second verse, "[Men] of every creed and race, Gather here before Thy face, Asking Thee to bless this place, God defend our free land. From dissension, envy, hate..." These words are at the heart of what we desire as a church as we today remember with great sadness the fifty-one lives that were lost so terribly as Muslims gathered together for Friday prayers, a year ago. Today in our services, we will be praying for the family and friends left behind and for the hope of the Gospel that is so needed in our country, especially for those who carry 'dissension, envy, hate' in their hearts. Gareth will lead us in prayer at each of our services, while Josh will honour the victims' memory in his sermon, as we continue our journey through Lent and what it means for us to be in exile.

### March 18, 2020 – St. George's AGM

With this aspiration in our hearts, this week, we also wish to remind you that we will be holding our **AGM on Wednesday, 18th of March 2020, at 7.30pm**. It would be great to see you there. It is good to report that this year, we have been environmentally-friendly and sent out **the AGM booklet via e-mail for the first time**. As Anglicans who 'care for God's good creation', we think that this is an important thing. Thanks so much to Lisa in the office for doing such a fantastic job of compiling it all and for those who submitted reports. **We encourage you to read them!** We will have some paper copies available for you to read along with some further printed booklets that add detail to the financial report and budget for the coming year. We can also report that we have had good nominations come through and that we are well-placed for another strong Vestry. Please pray for the teachers and the students as they negotiate, what is obviously a very difficult time for this kind of ministry. Please pray that in the midst of this, they would know the real presence of God, Our Comforter and also the hope through suffering, that Christ offers us all.
